[Belfast Zoo](#)

[Birdwatching](#)

Belfast Lough has been designated as an area of special scientific interest. Spectacular numbers of birds feed along the coast between Belfast and Whiteabbey, many on the mudflats and others immediately offshore. The whole area of Belfast Lough has been designated as having special scientific interest.

[Cycling](#)

The Newtownabbey Way project is a 9 mile route starting from Corrs Corner, linking the new Council Offices at Mossley Mill and then to Monkstown, Jordanstown, Whiteabbey, Whitehouse, Rathcoole, and the Valley Park. The new coastal path along the North Foreshore of Belfast Lough links Hazelbank Park to Dargan Road in Belfast. This new route is part of the National Cycle Network.

[Fishing](#)

The 32 acre lake at Straid Fishery is one of Ireland's top trout fisheries regularly yielding fish over 10lbs with both boat and bank fishing available. There is also a specimen pond with trout averaging 5lb (record 17lb 4ozs) and a separate worm/fly pond. Refreshments and fishing flies are available from the lodge. For the novice there are classes to introduce you to fly fishing.

Tildarg Fishery is renowned for its large fish. Tildarg is a 16 acre lake set in the hills just North of Ballyclare. It is stocked with 2 - 3lb rainbow trout and holding a stock of naturally breeding rainbows it provides excellent boat and bank fishing with easy access. Facilities include a purpose built fishery lodge including a shop, angler's rest room with log fire. There is an attached kitchen and toilets including ladies, gents and disabled. Flies, tackle, confectionery and cold drinks are available. There are wheelie boats that will take a wheel chair and have an electric engine, with are free to disabled anglers.

GOLF COURSES

[BALLYCLARE GOLF CLUB](#)

Set in the rolling, green countryside around the bustling, traditional market town of Ballyclare. This parkland course makes good use of the natural features of its landscape, in particular the local river and streams. The fairways are tree-lined and, as expected, accurate driving is required for a good score.

Fortwilliam Golf Club is located off the Antrim Road at Downview Avenue in the suburbs of North Belfast. It is situated in an area of natural beauty with the Cavehill to the north-west and Belfast Lough to the east. Although not a long course, it provides a good test of golf as most holes have narrow tree-lined fairways and small difficult-to-read greens. It measures just over 6000 yards with a Par of 70.

[GREENACRES GOLF CLUB](#)

A challenging parkland course designed to fit in with the natural rolling countryside of County Antrim, but its proximity to Belfast also makes it an ideal stop for a quick round with visitors based in the city. In addition to the course there is a 20 bay, fully floodlit driving range, perfect if you want to get in a little practice.
