Leisure and Sports Attractions

[Birdwatching](#): Spectacular numbers of birds feed along the coast between Belfast and Newtownabbey, many on the mudflats and others immediately offshore. The whole area of Belfast Lough has been designated as having special scientific interest.

[Cinema](#): The Movie House Glengormley is located 3 miles away and has 2 showings daily with a late show nightly. Matinees are at the weekend.

[Cycling](#): The Newtownabbey Way project is a nine mile route starting from the hotel, linking the new Council Offices at Mossley Mill and then to Monkstown, Jordansown, Whiteabbey, Rathcoole and the Valley Park.

[Fishing](#): Excellent coarse fishing and trout fishing available just minutes from the hotel on the [Sixmilewater River](#).

[Golf](#): Whatever kind of golfer you are, you can enjoy yourself in Newtownabbey, with golf courses for all abilities.

If it is practice and tuition you need then the professionals at Ballyearl or Greenacres will do their best to sort out your swing before letting you out for some target practice on the driving range.

The 18 hole parkland courses at Ballyclare and Greenacres provide challenging golf in the rolling County Antrim countryside.

[Sailing](#): The World Class marina at Carrickfergus is a mere 8 miles from Corr's Corner Hotel and increasingly Belfast Lough is becoming a venue for international sailing events.

[Theatre](#): If a night of drama, traditional music or comedy is what you want then The Courtyard Theatre at Ballyearl is for you. Located only 1.7 miles from the hotel.

The coastal scenery adjacent to the causeway is the some of the most beautiful and awe inspiring that you are likely to find anywhere. The majestic cliffs and inaccessible bays combine with myth and legend to inspire, but look carefully amongst the breathtaking landscape and you will find echoes of another reality, isolated ruins, kelp walls and shoreline fields bear testament to the harder life of subsistence farming and fishing endured by past generations. Dotted along the coast you'll find small sheltered harbours and slipways, fishermen's cottages and rock formations that you will never forget.

[Bushmills Distillery](#)

In 2008, Bushmills celebrated 400 years of local distilling history...a unique, unbroken whiskey-making tradition still very much alive today at the Old Bushmills Distillery. Just two miles from the spectacular Giant's Causeway, the distillery lies in an area of outstanding natural beauty which is rich in history and folklore.

At Bushmills, the visitor can observe the craft and skills of making Irish whiskey. The guided tour includes the ingredients and processes, spring water from Saint Columb's Rill and the finest malted barley, to the art of triple distillation in copper stills and ageing in oak casks. Of course, no visit would be complete without enjoying a complimentary glass of Bushmills whiskey.
